

A couple of early questions...

1. How do you get the artwork into canvas and other items? Some possibilities using Finerworks.com and the samples. Yes, there are other possibilities, but this is the one The Lord has shown me to use. He may show you to use a different one.

2. But I'm not creative?

A. Can you follow directions? I am not here to teach you art. I am here to teach you how to originate and operate a profitable e-commerce business that is evergreen, profitable, and totally minimizes possible money lose. And there's no reason why you can't include canvas art regardless of your passion/niche.

B. Can you copy and paste? And scoot a box around on a computer screen?

C. *You will also learn how to make money from a huge inventory of other peoples' "stuff"! As a matter of fact, you can create your business around this alone.*

3. How do I get my original art into a computer file and how do I put words on it?

Do you have a big enough scanner? If not, or if your scanner is not real high quality, an office supply place, a printing company, even an architect or engineering company may be able to help. Expect to pay a reasonable price for these services. You must get your original art work scanned into a digital file at 300 dpi, in high quality (some printers will "leak" light around them and you will end up with grayed or purple-ish inferior art). Your final product does not have to be higher resolution than 300 dpi file.

And, if you haven't started your original art, decide what you want to do with it and keep it in those exact ratios - but better to keep it in that exact size. I will totally explain with screen shots in a different module.

4. I don't want to bug my friends and family to buy my stuff!

I want to blow that little tiny mindset up! I want you to market all across the USA and if your family and friends want some, great, sell it to them or give to them for a birthday present, *but never at cost! Either make profit or give it away.*

5. How does he market it? It would cost so much to start a retail store, and then the hours. Right now, he sells stuff on Craig's List® or Ebay®. But it's not real steady. You mean he can make a real good income?

Yes, an excellent income. He will not be limited to a small area or region for buyers, he can work whatever hours he wants, where ever he wants, his store will be open 24/7.
